

Hawaii Hospitals Community Health Needs Assessment KEY FINDINGS

Overarching Themes

1. All groups experience adverse health outcomes due to **chronic disease and health risk behaviors**
2. Greater socio-economic need and health impacts are found among **certain groups and places** in Hawaii
3. **Cultural and language barriers** inhibit effective intervention for the most impacted populations
4. **Limited access to care** results in greater health impacts
5. **Community health centers and schools** are key community assets for effective interventions
